The last part of the call we spent hearing updates from the kitchens that were on the call:

Detroit Kitchen Connect - Devita Davidson

On July 27th they launched their network of three kitchens. The received 15 applications and accepted 7. Three are working out of one kitchen and four out of another. The received a \$1,000,000 grant from the Michigan Economic Development Corporation which will be coupled with an additional \$1,000,000 and used to build a \$2,000,000 kitchen facility in the Eastern Market which will open in the 1st quarter of 2014.

Cleveland Crops - Paul Keida and Chris Yurick

They are currently under construction. The "dry" side of the kitchen will be finished first. The equipment is arriving today and they will be open to process crops from this season. They have a 2000 member CSA. Their CSA members will also be their first processed foods customers. They have a sales manager who helps them decided what to grow on their farms (around 60 acres) and what to process.

Local Roots - Brian Gwin

Nathan has left for DC. The kitchen is being wrapped up. They have hired a kitchen manager and are advertising for Food Processing Entrepreneurs, who are people who would work with area farms on the processing/preserving end.

Lake to River Cooperative

They have made great progress. The front of their facility which houses the food coop is finished and they are currently working on the kitchen facility which is in the back.

Lorain Incubator Kitchen Cooperative

They are in the process of choosing a site from three available. Each site has its advantages and disadvantages.
